What is it? The Parent Registry is a list of Yale University affiliated parents who are willing to share their experiences with public and private child care providers with other Yale affiliated parents. *The nature of their experiences and their expressed opinions are not monitored or tracked by the WorkLife Program, which does not endorse or refer any specific provider.*

How does it work? Upon your request, the WorkLife Program will provide a list of parents who have past or current experience with a specific provider. In turn, you may wish to be listed as a resource for other parents seeking child care. The purpose of this service is to give parents an opportunity to talk with other parents.

Who may use it? This service is for current members of the Yale University community.
